**Stubby:** (wild born ~ age unknown) She was rescued in November 1995 from the St. John's River in Duval County, FL after a boat strike. A large portion of her paddle is gone, removed during surgery after her accident. She can be identified by her injured paddle & the large wrinkle across her snout. Stubby came to us from SeaWorld in October 2005 & weighed in at 1,950 lbs. She has had recurring problems with her health & along with the damage to her tail; she is conditionally non-releasable but is re-evaluated every 5 years as to whether she would be released back to the wild.

**Erie:** Female (wild born) Rescued Jan 9, 2025. Rescued at 110 lbs as an orphan calf with cold stress in the DeSot Canal area in Cocoa Beach, FL.

**Redrock:** Female (wild born) Rescued May 10, 2024 at 49 lbs. as an orphan calf in the Indian River, Titusville, FL.

**Rosalyn:** Female (wild born) Rescued Dec. 2, 2024. Rescued at 50 lbs as an orphan calf in the Banana River Cocoa Beach, FL.
